

## Dordogne 2018

Friday June 1<sup>st</sup> until Saturday June 16<sup>th</sup> (15 Nights)

The rally will be mainly do as you please days with casual evenings with happy hours/hospitality, Restaurant and DIY meals, BBQ's & Boules arranged.

The sites all have heated pools and said to be of a high standard

The first two sites are ACSI Low season discount sites and so you are advised to update your membership

Places to visit during the rally include the Padirac chasm, Rocamadour, Collonges-la-Rouge, Sarlat, Domme and the many other beautiful villages in the area.

June 1<sup>st</sup> - 6<sup>th</sup>

The first site we intend to visit is at **Beaulieu-sur-Dordogne** this is a commune in the Corrèze department in the Nouvelle-Aquitaine region of central France. Beaulieu is a medieval city, originally dominated by its great abbey of St Pierre, of which only the abbey church remains. The campsite is located on an island on the Dordogne river opposite the medieval town of Beaulieu-sur-Dordogne.



June 6<sup>th</sup> - 11<sup>th</sup> June

We then move about 30 miles to a site 5 miles from **Souillac**. The site is a medieval village (3 farmhouses) restored and reconstructed into an 80 hectare campsite, all of this without losing its authenticity. Positioned on a hill with lovely views and romantic sunsets. This, with all the facilities you would expect, means this Castels campsite deserves its five stars.

June 11<sup>th</sup> - June 16<sup>th</sup>

Finally we move another 30 miles to Beynac - et -Cazeneuc The site shown in the foreground of the picture is on the edge of the small tourist town and is on the river and overlooked by the Chateau.
